Service Providers who participated in the Oncor program in 2011, and those who plan to participate in 2012, please read this [entire](#) message.

### 1. 2011 Project Extensions

Yesterday Oncor authorized our team to continue working with projects approved in 2011 but that were not offered a full 6 month term to complete and were not completed prior to the December 7, 2011 deadline. For those projects, we can now offer extensions to achieve up to a full 6 month term, but but not beyond February 28, 2012. Again, the criteria are for extension eligibility are:

- Oncor PV projects that were initially awarded an incentive later than 6/7/2011, and
- Did not complete (did not submit a complete FAF) by 12/7/2011.

If you have any Oncor projects that meet these criteria, you should first recontact your customers and then our team to let us know whether you and your customer would like an extension. For projects that meet these criteria, we may be able to offer an extension up to, but not beyond, February 28, 2012. You must use the attached form to make an extension request.

### 2. Continuing Development of 2012 Program

Oncor has extended the opportunity of a 2012 program. Getting a 2012 program fully underway is now a 2-step process, and we have completed the first step. The second step will be execution of a new 2012 Statement of Work that fully details a 2012 program design. Oncor's authorization makes reference to the fact that a 2012 Statement of Work contract is underway, but that finalized terms have not been issued.

As we have stated before, we have every indication and expectation that a 2012 program will ultimately be approved, and that it will contain sufficient new funds to cover all projects currently in queue as well as many more. For this reason, the Oncor program continues to remain open to new applications. However, we cannot begin approving any new or queued applications until a final 2012 program contract is signed, and unfortunately we cannot guarantee exactly when, or even whether, that will occur. No budget can be confirmed until an executed Statement of Work is issued. We will provide more information via this listserve and the program website as soon as it is available.

### 3. Questions

Our team fully realizes that program uncertainty poses real challenges for you and your customers' planning and decision-making, and we recognize that this announcement reopens some project completion possibilities that had been previously closed. We are glad to share this news about a program extension, and remain committed to providing you with the most accurate and timely information possible so that you and your customers are fully informed of your options at all times.
