



Oncor Solar PV Incentive Program Program Notice Circulated 6/24/2010

After reopening the Oncor PV incentive program on June 21st to new applications, we received over 150 new requests for funding for both residential and non-residential projects.

Residential applications:

- On Monday June 21, 2010 we received approximately 97 residential funding applications totaling more than \$1.4 million in incentive requests. These new requests plus previous queued requests exceed our available budget by about 15%. The residential program is currently open and will remain open to new applications until requests exceed available budget by 25%-30%.
- We expect to be able to provide Funding Reservation Letters for about 65 residential projects by the end of next week (Friday, July 2). If you do not receive a Funding Reservation Letter by the end of next week (Friday, July 2), we will reassess the non-residential budget and make any additional awards that are possible in mid-July. We may be able to make a small number additional awards after mid-July, depending on project expirations and withdrawals.

Non-residential applications:

- On Monday June 21, 2010 we received approximately 57 non-residential funding applications totaling more than \$2.6 million in incentive requests. These new requests plus previous queued requests significantly exceed our available budget. Because of this, the non-residential program is now closed to new applications, and no new non-residential applications will be accepted.
- We expect to be able to provide Funding Reservation Letters for about 12 non-residential projects by the end of this week. If you do not receive an Funding Reservation Letter by the end of this week (Friday, June 25), we will reassess the non-residential budget and make any additional awards that are possible in mid-July. We may be able to make a small number additional awards after mid-July, depending on project expirations and withdrawals.
