Take A Load Off, TexasSM is provided by Oncor Electric Delivery LLC as part of the company's commitment to reduce energy consumption and demand. Frontier Associates and Clean Energy Associates implement the Take A Load Off, Texas Solar PV Program as an independent contractor.



Service Provider Eligibility

- New Service Provider eligibility requirements (effective date July 1, 2009)
 - Remove 40 hours of training as sufficient for becoming a registered Service Provider
 - Not applicable to any Service Providers who submit complete registrations by June 30 or earlier
 - Policy implementation date is intended to respect companies who have signed up for training events with the intent of registering for the program over the next couple of months



Interconnection Process (reminder)

Interconnection is a 2 step process which occurs (mostly) outside the program/incentive process

1. Interconnection Application

- Start the Oncor interconnection process by filing an Interconnection Application as soon as possible after receiving program commitment letter
- Should submit interconnection application as soon as final design (equipment and layout) is complete

2. Interconnection Agreement

- Oncor will send customer 2 copies of an Interconnection Agreement to be signed and returned by the customer
- Oncor may take several weeks to sign and return signed Interconnection Agreement to customer
- Signed agreement is needed before check request can be made
